PrideMajic.com is a division of 2Dudes1Dream LLC ("Pride Majic," "we," "our," or "us"). We respect your privacy and are committed to being clear about how we collect, use, disclose, and protect personal information when you visit PrideMajic.com, make a purchase, create an account, submit custom content, communicate with us, or otherwise interact with our products and services.

This Privacy Policy applies to our website, online store, customer service interactions, and related services that link to this policy. It does not apply to third-party websites, platforms, or services that maintain their own privacy policies.

1. Personal Information We Collect

The personal information we collect depends on how you interact with us. Categories may include:

- **Contact information:** name, email address, telephone number, billing address, shipping address, and other contact details.
- **Order and transaction information:** products purchased, order history, transaction amount, shipping details, returns or issue-resolution information, and related purchase records.
- **Payment information:** payment card and other payment details are generally collected and processed by our payment service providers. We may receive limited payment-related information such as payment status, card type, or the last digits of a payment method.
- **Account information:** account credentials, account preferences, saved addresses, and related profile information if you create an account.
- **Custom order content:** artwork, images, files, text, personalization instructions, logos, or other materials you choose to provide for a custom product or project.
- **Communications:** messages, emails, reviews, survey responses, customer-service requests, and other information you provide when you contact us.
- **Device and usage information:** IP address, browser type, device identifiers, operating system, pages viewed, referring pages, approximate location derived from IP address, shopping activity, and interactions with our website or marketing.
- **Marketing preferences:** email subscription status, communication preferences, and your interactions with promotional messages.

Because our products may relate to identity, community, or personal expression, purchase history may sometimes reveal or suggest personal interests. We treat purchase and order history as personal information and use it only for the purposes described in this policy.



2. How We Collect Information

We may collect personal information:

- Directly from you, such as when you place an order, create an account, contact us, subscribe to marketing, or submit a custom design.
- Automatically, through cookies, pixels, log files, and similar technologies when you use our website.
- From service providers and business partners that help us operate our store, process payments, deliver orders, prevent fraud, provide analytics, or support marketing and advertising.

3. How We Use Personal Information

We may use personal information to:

- Process, fulfill, ship, and manage orders, including custom orders and customer requests.
- Provide customer service, respond to questions, and resolve order or product issues.
- Create and manage customer accounts and preferences.
- Operate, maintain, personalize, and improve our website, products, and services.
- Communicate about orders, account activity, policy changes, and other service-related matters.
- Send marketing or promotional communications when permitted by law. You may unsubscribe at any time using the link in our marketing emails or by contacting us.
- Measure website performance, understand customer interactions, and improve our marketing and merchandising.
- Detect, investigate, and prevent fraud, abuse, security incidents, or other harmful activity.
- Comply with legal obligations, enforce our terms, and protect the rights, safety, and property of Pride Majic, our customers, and others.

4. Cookies, Analytics, and Advertising Technologies

We and our service providers may use cookies, pixels, tags, local storage, and similar technologies to operate our website and understand how it is used. These technologies may help us keep items in your shopping cart, remember preferences, measure site performance, analyze traffic, prevent fraud, and deliver or measure advertising.

You can control many cookies through your browser settings and, where available, through cookie or privacy controls on our website. Blocking some cookies may affect site features or functionality. Some browsers also offer a "Do Not Track" setting; because there is no single universally accepted standard for those signals, our website may not respond to all of them. Where applicable law requires us to recognize a valid browser-based opt-out preference signal, we will process that signal as required by law.

5. How We Disclose Personal Information

We may disclose personal information to the following categories of recipients when reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this policy:

- E-commerce, hosting, and technology providers that support our website and store operations.
- Payment processors, financial service providers, and fraud-prevention providers.
- Shipping carriers, fulfillment providers, printers, production partners, and other vendors involved in completing your order when applicable.
- Analytics, marketing, and advertising providers that help us understand website performance or communicate with customers and prospective customers.



- Professional advisers such as accountants, attorneys, insurers, and consultants when necessary for legitimate business purposes.
- Government agencies, regulators, courts, or law enforcement when required by law or when reasonably necessary to protect legal rights, safety, or security.
- A buyer, successor, or other party involved in a merger, acquisition, financing, reorganization, sale of assets, or similar business transaction, subject to appropriate protections.
- Other parties when you direct us to share information or provide your consent.

We do not sell personal information for monetary consideration. Some privacy laws define "sale" or "sharing" more broadly and may treat certain targeted advertising or cross-context behavioral advertising activities as a sale or sharing. Where those laws apply, you may have the right to opt out as described below.

6. Payment Processing

Payments are processed through third-party payment providers. We do not generally store complete payment card numbers or security codes on our own systems. Payment providers process payment information under their own terms and privacy practices.

7. Data Retention

We retain personal information for as long as reasonably necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this policy, including to provide services, maintain business and tax records, resolve disputes, prevent fraud, enforce agreements, and comply with legal obligations. Retention periods vary depending on the type of information, the purpose for which it was collected, and applicable legal requirements.

8. Data Security

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect personal information. These measures may include access controls, secure service providers, encryption in transit where appropriate, and security monitoring. No method of transmission or storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

9. Your Privacy Rights and Choices

Depending on where you live and the laws that apply, you may have rights regarding your personal information, including the right to:

- Request access to or confirmation of the personal information we process about you.
- Request correction of inaccurate personal information.
- Request deletion of personal information, subject to legal exceptions.
- Request a portable copy of certain personal information.
- Opt out of certain targeted advertising, sale, sharing, or profiling activities where applicable.
- Withdraw consent where our processing is based on consent.
- Opt out of marketing communications at any time.

request on your behalf, we may require proof of the agent's authority and may still need to verify your identity directly.

We will not discriminate against you for exercising a privacy right. If applicable law gives you a right to appeal a decision we make regarding a privacy request, you may submit an appeal by contacting us and stating that you are appealing a privacy-rights decision.

10. Minnesota Privacy Rights

If you are a Minnesota resident and the Minnesota Consumer Data Privacy Act applies to our processing of your personal data, you may have additional rights, including rights to access, correct, delete, and obtain a portable copy of certain personal data; opt out of certain targeted advertising, sale, or qualifying profiling; and request information about third parties to which personal data has been disclosed, subject to the law's definitions, exceptions, and verification requirements.

Minnesota privacy requests may be submitted using the contact methods in Section 15. We will respond within the time required by applicable law and will provide information about any available appeal process if we deny a request.

11. Third-Party Websites and Services

Our website may link to third-party websites, social media platforms, applications, or services. We do not control their privacy or security practices. Your interactions with those third parties are governed by their own policies and terms, and we encourage you to review them before providing personal information.

12. Children's Privacy

Our website and services are not directed to children under 13, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If you believe a child under 13 has provided personal information to us, please contact us so we can take appropriate steps to delete it.

13. International Visitors

Pride Majic is based in the United States. If you access our website from outside the United States, your personal information may be processed in the United States or other countries where our service providers operate. Data protection laws in those locations may differ from the laws in your country. Where required, we use appropriate safeguards for international transfers.

14. Changes to This Privacy Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time to reflect changes in our practices, technology, services, or legal requirements. When we make changes, we will update the "Last Updated" date at the top of this policy. If required by law, we will provide additional notice of material changes.
